<b>What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a>?</b>	Network: \$6,700 – Individual or \$13,400 – Family  Non-Network: \$20,100 – Individual or \$40,200 – Family	See the Common Medical Events chart below for your costs for services this <a href="#">plan</a> covers. Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <a href="#">providers</a> up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a> , each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a> .
<b>Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a>?</b>	Yes. Primary Care Visit to Treat an Injury or Illness, Preventive Care/Screening/Immunization, Laboratory Outpatient and Professional Services, X-rays and Diagnostic Imaging, Outpatient Facility Fee, Outpatient Surgery Physician/Surgical Services, Urgent Care Centers or Facilities, Outpatient - Mental/Behavioral Health Services Office, Prenatal and Postnatal Care, Child - Routine Eye Exam, Child - Eye Glasses, Child - Dental Check-Up	This <a href="#">plan</a> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount. <b>Are there other <a href="#">deductibles</a> for specific services?</b>	No	You don't have to meet <a href="#">deductibles</a> for specific services.
<b>What is the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> for this <a href="#">plan</a>?</b>	Network: \$8,700 – Individual or \$17,400 – Family  Non-Network: Not Applicable	The <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <a href="#">plan</a> , they have to meet their own <a href="#">out-of-pocket limits</a> until the overall family <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> has been met.
<b>What is not included in the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a>?</b>	<a href="#">Premiums</a> , <a href="#">balance-billing</a> charges, and health care this <a href="#">plan</a> doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> .

Be aware, your <a href="#">network provider</a> might use an <a href="#">out-of-network provider</a> for some services (such as lab work). ### Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes
