Starting January 1, 2022, **review of radiology, genetic testing, and radiation oncology services for Bright HealthCare™ members** will be performed by **AIM Specialty Health® (AIM)**. AIM works with leading insurers to improve healthcare quality and manage costs for today's most complex and prevalent tests and treatments, helping to promote care that is appropriate, safe, and affordable.

This change applies to all Bright HealthCare members in your area, **except Medicare Advantage members**.

To determine medical necessity, AIM will follow the clinical hierarchy established by Bright HealthCare. If existing guidance does not provide sufficient clinical detail, AIM will decide using an objective, evidence-based process.

Pre-service review requirements

Starting December 20, 2021, contact AIM for prior authorization of services that will take place in 2022. Please make sure you have a prior authorization before scheduling and performing any service.

Contact AIM for a pre-service review for the following non-emergency services:

Radiology services:

- Nuclear imaging, including myocardial perfusion imaging, cardiac blood pool imaging, infarct imaging, and positron emission tomography (PET) myocardial imaging
- Computed tomography (CT), including CT angiography, derived fractional flow reserve, structural CT, and quantitative evaluation of coronary calcification
- Magnetic resonance imaging (MRI)
- Magnetic resonance angiography (MRA)
- Magnetic resonance spectroscopy (MRS)
- Functional MRI (fMRI)

Genetic testing

- Reproductive carrier screening
- Prenatal testing
- Preimplantation genetic testing (PGT), for members with this benefit
- Rare disease testing
- Whole exome/genome sequencing
- Hereditary cancer testing



- Tumor markers
- Hereditary cardiac testing
- Neurogenetic and neuromuscular testing
- Pharmacogenomics and thrombophilia testing
- Susceptibility testing for common diseases

- 2D conventional and 3D conformal radiation therapy
- Brachytherapy
