TIMING CHANGE Medical specialty drugs authorization program

Bright HealthCare has postponed for at least 60 days the go-live of the new authorization program through Magellan for medical specialty drugs. Bright HealthCare will communicate about the new implementation date soon. **Please continue to follow the current authorization submission process for medical specialty drugs.** This program will not apply to California.

Outpatient Site of Service program

Bright HealthCare conducts medical necessity review for various services. The review includes an evaluation of cost-effectiveness. Services that are in scope for the Site of Service program will be reviewed to determine if the member can receive the services at a lower-cost setting. When clinically appropriate, members will only receive coverage under their Bright HealthCare plan for services in a lower-cost setting.
